

"Show you..."



Matthew 4:19, 20... Jesus called out to them, "Come, follow me, and I will show you how to fish for people!" And they left their nets at once and followed him.

As we move into the summer months, we are preparing to have a conversation about what it means to "follow" Jesus, and what does being a disciple of Jesus today look like in our everyday lives.

Our sermon series will focus on the 12 disciples that followed Jesus; their personality traits and characteristics that made them into followers of Jesus and caused them to make disciples with Jesus.want to follow Jesus. We will keep asking the question, why did Jesus choose these men and why does Jesus still choose people to be His disciples who make disciples?

In Matthew 4, we see a willingness from Jesus to show his followers how to make disciples. Notice He never directly speaks about showing them how to BE a disciple. Jesus promises to "show them how"...

Throughout the years, I have always been a visual tactile learner. I learn best and retain knowledge longer when I can see it, experience it or get my hands dirty doing it. I have never really been a good

student when it came to reading books, taking tests and taking notes. I can do all of that but that is not the best learning method for me, especially if I want to remember the information. I was never a good test taker because I would get nervous over the amount of time given to take the test and I could never recall the information I was supposed to retain. Maybe this has been true for you over the years.

Jesus is a much different teacher. He was always showing the disciples how to do something or telling them stories that related to life situations that they were already familiar with and comfortable retelling so they could learn how to be a committed follower. It is comforting to me that Jesus is still willing to show us how to make disciples and He transforms our hearts in the midst of doing to being more and more like Him.

Here is the key... doing something to bring honor and glory to Jesus before we are fully made into (being) a disciple of Jesus. Jesus wants to use you because you are ordinary and wiling to learn; you are open to doing something for Jesus even though you may not have all the knowledge you need about Jesus. Jesus wants you to share what you know about Him with others who are willing to listen. Jesus will show you how to make disciples; He will be with you every step of the way.

The Fourth of July—also known as Independence Day or July 4th—has been a federal holiday in the United States since 1941, but the tradition of Independence Day celebrations goes back to the 18th century and the



American Revolution. On July 2nd, 1776, the Continental Congress voted in favor of independence, and two days later delegates from the 13 colonies adopted the Declaration of Independence, a historic document drafted by Thomas Jefferson. From 1776 to the present day, July 4th has been celebrated as the birth of American independence, with festivities ranging from fireworks, parades and concerts to more casual family gatherings and barbecues.

Did you know? John Adams believed that July 2nd was the correct date on which to celebrate the birth of American independence, and would reportedly turn down invitations to appear at July 4th events in protest. Adams and Thomas Jefferson both died on July 4, 1826—the 50th anniversary of the adoption of the Declaration of Independence.
